5. Who was asked to go first?

Ans. Yudhishtira was asked to go first.

6. What did he see?

Ans. Yudhishtira could see the trees, sky and his teacher.

7. What answer did all the students have?

Ans. All the students answered that they could see the trees, sky and Dronacharya, their teacher.

8. Who did Dronacharya call last? What did he see?

Ans. Dronacharya called Arjuna last. Arjuna could only see the eye of the bird.

9. What did Dronacharya explain to the other students?

Ans. Dronacharya explained to other students that if they could keep their eyes only on goal, then nothing could stop them from achieving it.
